

OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE: DELHI

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 35 of the Delhi Police Act, 1978 the following directions are hereby issued for the purpose of prevention and control of the outbreak of pandemic disease namely COVID-19 in the National Capital Territory of Delhi, with immediate effect :-

- (i) All members of public to remain indoor, as far as possible and not to come outside unnecessarily for leisure or entertainment activities which involves close contact with more than 5 persons at any place.
- (ii) Not to assemble in excess of 5 persons at any place for protest, dharna, rally, or any such activity, whether in closed space or outside.
- (iii) Not to assemble for public entertainment activities in excess of 5 persons.
- (iv) All public transport including buses, metros, TSRs, Gramin Sewas, Maxi Cabs and Eco Friendly Sewas should be disinfected daily.
- (v) Any person contravening this order shall be punishable u/s 114 of DELHI POLICE ACT, 1978.
- (vi) As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned, the order is, hereby, passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through press and affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of all DCsP, Addl. DCsP, ACsP, Tehsils, all Police Stations and offices of the New Delhi Municipal Corporation and North Delhi Municipal Corporation, East Delhi Municipal Corporation, South Delhi Municipal Corporation, Public Works Department, Delhi Development Authority and Delhi Cantonment Board.

This order will come into force and if not withdrawn earlier will be applicable from 18.03.2020 to 31.03.2020.
