Hence in pursuance of the aforementioned directions and in exercise of powers conferred under section 30 (2) (iv) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, it is hereby ordered that the aforementioned New Guidelines (As per Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) Order No. 40-3/2020-DM- I (A) Dated 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2020) as well as the National Directives as must be enforced by all concerned/stakeholders in the manner prescribed below:-

1. All eateries, restaurants, sweet shop, tea stall etc. will not be allowed to operate.

2. The Shops will be allowed to run/operate in the MC area as per the scheduled prescribed below:
