THE FACTORIES (PUNJAB AMENDMENT) BILL, 2020

(Punjab Act No. 19 of 2020)

AN

ACT

further to amend the Factories Act, 1948, in its application to the State of Punjab.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Seventyfirst Year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

This Act may be called the Factories (Punjab Amendment) Act, Short title and 2020.

commencement.

- (2) It shall come into force on and with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- In the Factories Act, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), Amendment of in its application to the State of Punjab, in section 2, in clause (m),-

- in sub-clause (i), for the word "ten", the word "twenty" shall be ¹⁹⁴⁸. substituted; and
- in sub-clause (ii), for the word "twenty", the word "forty" shall be substituted.
- In the principal Act, in section 65, in sub-section (3), in clause (iv), for Amendment of the word "seventy-five", the words "one hundred and fifteen" shall be section 65 of substituted.

In the principal Act, in section 85, in sub-section (1), in clause (i), for the Amendment of words "ten" and "twenty", the words "twenty" and "forty" shall, respectively, section 85 of be substituted.

5. In the principal Act, after section 106A, the following section shall be Insertion of new inserted, namely:-

section 106B in Central Act 63 of

"106B. The Inspector may, subject to any general or special order of 1948. Compounding the State Government in this behalf, compound any offence of offences. (except offences under Chapter IV and IV A of the Factories Act, 1948) punishable under this Act with fine only, and committed for the first time, either before or after the institution of the prosecution, on realization of such amount of composition fee as he thinks fit not exceeding the maximum amount of fine fixed for the offence; and where the offence is so compounded,-

- (i) before the institution of the prosecution, the offender shall not be liable to prosecution, for such offence and shall, if in custody, be set at liberty;
- after the institution of the prosecution, the composition shall amount to acquittal of the offender.".
- 6. (1) The Factories (Punjab Amendment) Ordinance, 2020 (Punjab Repeal and saving. Ordinance No. 3 of 2020), is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the Ordinance referred to in sub-section (1), shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of this Act.
