Whereas the work of obtaining deck levels and inspection of existing Zuari bridge located on National Highway-17 is planned from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. on first Sunday i.e. on 02nd May, 2021, for which the bridge needs to be closed for all ongoing traffic and needs to be diverted via Borim on NH-17B and also via ferry boats from across river Zuari from Cortalim to Agassaim & vice versa.

Whereas power to function as highway administration as delegated vide SO No. 3292E duly published in Gazette of India vide No. 3012 Extraordinary Part-II Section 3 sub-section (ii) dated 16-09-2019 to the respective Executive Engineer to discharge the functions of Highway Administration under Section 33 of control to National Highway Act, 2002.

Whereas MORT&H vide letter No. NH-11011/33//2019-LA dated 18-09-2019 has confirmed delegated of powers to the competent authority to discharge the functions of Highway Administration.

Therefore, I, Shri Dattaprasad Kamat, the Executive Engineer of Division XIV(NH), PWD, Fatorda, Margao-Goa, in-charge of Highway stretch of NH-17 (NH-66) hereby orders for closure of existing Zuari bridge for all types of traffic from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. on 2nd May, 2021 (Sunday) to enable Assistant Engineer, SD I, WDXIV(NH), PWD, Cortalim to record deck levels and also direct the diversion of all traffic via Borim bridge on NH-17B and through ferry boat across river Zuari.

Four hump type speed breakers near Shailesh Bhagat house and Prabhu house in ward No. II

 Two hump type speed breakers to be constructed at a distance admeasuring I 15 meters prior to the junction on either side of the main road near the house of Shailesh Bhagat, Corlim

Two hump type speed breakers to be constructed at a distance admeasuring 15 meters prior to the junction on either side of the main road near the house of Prabhu, Corlim

Four hump type speed breakers near Banastarkar house and Gannus house in Ward No. II, PDA Colony

Two hump type speed breakers to be constructed at a distance admeasuring 15 meters prior to the junction on either side of the main road near the house of Gannus, Corlim

Eight hump type speed breakers near Panchayat Park, near Corlim Church & near Jesus & Mary School, Corlim in ward No. VII

3. Two hump type speed breakers to be constructed at a distance admeasuring Breaker 15 meters prior to the junction on either side of the main road near Jesus & Mary Type) School, Corlim

Three hump type speed breakers to be constructed at a distance admeasuring 15 meters prior to the junction on all 3 arms of Y-junction near the house of Rosario, Corlim

One hump type speed breaker to be constructed at a distance admeasuring 15 meters prior to Village Panchayat Corlim on the road between the Corlim Church and Village Panchayat Corlim

Two hump type speed breakers to be constructed at a distance admeasuring 15 meters prior to the junction (on the Y-junction), near Children's Park, Corlim

The above Speed Breakers shall be painted with white thermoplastic fluorescent paint and fixed with reflected road studs around it for better visibility.

Further, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Section 116 of the above Act, I also authorize the erection of cautionary sign boards "Speed Breaker", at about 40 mts. on either side of the speed breaker in advance of the rumbler strips and traffic signboard showing the sign "Speed Breaker" at the placement of the speed breaker in order to regulate the motor vehicular traffic.

The Secretary, Village Panchayat, Corlim, Tiswadi is directed to publish this notification through the Director of Information and Publicity in local newspapers and P. W.D. (Engineering Cell) to make necessary arrangements to construct the Speed Breakers as also Rumbles Speed Breakers and to erect the signboards at the places indicated above as per the specification laid down by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways and as published in the Official Gazette Series I No. 15 dated 15-07-2005 by the Government of Goa and report compliance within fifteen days time.

P. Siolim-Sodiem jurisdiction between 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on 12-04-2021.

And whereas, the Dy. Supdt. of Police Traffic (North), Altinho, Panaji has recommended for closure of road for vehicular traffic from Holy Cross High School, Gaunsavaddo, Sodiem and Cuchelim Junction and diversion of vehicular traffic from Marna to Mapusa route and Mapusa to Marna to carry out work of replacement of electricity poles in V. P. Siolim-Sodiem jurisdiction between 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on holidays preferably on Sunday as it creates traffic congestion on working days.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Sections 115 & 116 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, and as recommended by the Dy. Superintendent of Police (Traffic), Altinho, Panaji, I, Ajit Roy, IAS, District Magistrate, North Goa hereby order for closure of road for vehicular traffic from Holy Cross High School, Gaunsavaddo Sodiem and Cuchelim Junction and diversion of vehicular traffic from Marna to Mapusa route and Mapusa to Marna to carry out work of replacement of electricity poles in V. P. Siolim-Sodiem jurisdiction between 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., on holidays preferably on Sunday, subject to the following conditions:-

- VP/Contractor is directed to erect sufficient traffic signages/directional boards regarding closure at diversion points for the information of motorists and other road users.
- VP/Contractor is directed to give notice through Press/Media regarding closure and diversion of the road on receipt of this Notification for the information of the motorists and other road users.
- VP/Contractor shall post sufficient number of Traffic Marshals at diversion points to guide the motorist regarding diversion.
- 4. Prior permission from other competent authorities should be obtained in advance.
- 5. NOC from concerned Police Station should be obtained.
- Material used for barricading the road should be painted/pasted with fluorescent paint/tape for illuminating the same during the night time.
- Material used for barricading of road should be removed immediately and the road should be thrown open for vehicular flow after resurfacing the same.
