Clinics and other institutions can apply for registration under the Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act 2021 & the Surrogacy (Regulation) Act 2021

According to the Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act 2021 & The Surrogacy (Regulation) Act 2021, institutions providing reproductive infertility services should take steps for registration as soon as possible. Government and private sector clinics, centres, laboratories, genetic counseling centres, assisted reproductive technology banks, institutions dealing with human gametes and embryos for surrogacy etc. are required to register under this Act. Application form for registration and more details are available at https://registry.artsurrogacy.gov.in.

The registration fee should be paid into Treasury Savings Bank Account No. 799011400007601 in the name of the Chairperson of the appropriate authority for the purpose of registration. Assisted Reproductive Technology Banks pay a registration fee of Rs. 50,000, Level 1 Clinics Rs. 50,000, Level 2 Clinics Rs. 2,00,000 and Surrogacy Clinics Rs.2,00,000. This amount can be paid online or in person. Government institutions are not required to pay any fee for registration.

The registration certificate should be visibly displayed in the establishments. Failure to comply with the law will have the authority to cancel the registration.
