As per SWM Rules '2016, "Bulk Waste Generator (BWGs)" includes those buildings having an averagewaste generation rate exceeding 100kg per day. As such, the malls, function halls, hotels & restaurants generating Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) above 100 kg per day on an average falls under the category of BWGs. As per Sub-Rule (8) of Rule 4 (Duties of waste generators)- All hotels and restaurants shall, within one year from the date of notification of these rules and in partnership with the local body ensure segregation of waste at source as prescribed in these rules, facilitate collection of segregated waste in separate streams, handover recyclable material to either the authorised waste pickers or the authorised recyclers. The bio-degradable waste shall be processed, treated and disposed off through composting or biomethanation within the premises as far as possible. The residual waste shall be given to the waste collectors or agency as directed by the local body.

In this regard, it is to inform that, M/s Hyderabad Integrated MSW Ltd(HIMSW) is the only Waste Collector Authorized by GHMC to collect the MSW/residual waste from all the BWGs in GHMC area duly collecting user charges declared by the GHMC which shall be notified by the GHMC from time to time. The user charges for the Financial Year 2022-23 are Rs.2.90/- per kg of MSW/ Residual waste towards collection, transportation, treatment & disposal of the same. In case the Bulk Waste Generator wants to transport their MSW in accordance with SWM Rules' 2016 and hand over to M/s HIMSW at the MSW Treatment & Disposal Facility at Jawaharnagar they shall pay Rs. 1.16 per kg of MSW as the user charge.

Hence, all Malls, Function Halls, 3 Star & above Hotels, Restaurants and Bars who generate more than 100 kg of MSW per day on an average shall comply with the above direction. This notification is issued in compliance to Solid Waste Management Rules' 2016 and action shall be initiated against those who fails to comply with the provisions of these rules and do not comply with this notice.
